STUDENT CHECKLIST

For Online Music Lessons

DEVICE

First, don't use public internet connection nor borrowed devices. For your online lessons, you can use tablet, smartphone or laptop computer with video streaming capability. Please be sure that your device is fully charged or plugged in (with a long enough extension cord!) during your online lesson. Please use Laptop if you can. Zoom shut off the keyboard sound with tablet or smartphone.

HIGH-SPEED INTERNET

Your internet speed should be at least 20-35mbps upload and 2-3mbps download speed. If you are not sure what your internet speed is, currently you can check at www.speedtest.net.

VIDEO CALLING SOFTWARE

Please download FaceTime (google), Messenger (facebook), or Zoom to your device for online lessons. Let me know your username prior to the lesson so I can add you as a contact.

INSTRUMENT

You obviously need your instrument during online lessons. Make sure that your instrument is ready and in tune.

STOOL or TABLET STAND

Please find a stool or desk to place your device. The device should be positioned so I can clearly see you and the instrument. Here is a <u>recommended tablet stand</u>.

MUSIC MATERIALS
